

TROUVER (TO FIND) - CONDITIONAL TENSE

LESSON OBJECTIVES

The objective of this lesson is to learn how to conjugate **Trouver** (to find) in the conditional tense.

INTRODUCTION

- **Trouver** is a regular verb. It belongs to the 1st group.
 - It is conjugated with the auxiliary **avoir** in the past tense.
 - It can also be used in the pronominal form: **se trouver** (to find oneself...), in which case it is conjugated with the auxiliary **être**.
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TROUVER (CONDITIONAL TENSE)

- je trouverais
 - tu trouverais
 - il trouverait
 - elle trouverait
 - on trouverait
 - nous trouverions
 - vous trouveriez
 - ils trouveraient
 - elles trouveraient
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EXAMPLES

- **Je trouverais cet examen très dur si je ne révisais pas.**
I would find this exam very hard if I was not revising.
- **Si tu habitais à la campagne tu trouverais la vie plus saine.**
If you were living in the countryside, you would find life healthier.
- **Si tu habitais à la campagne tu trouverais la vie moins stressante.**
If you were living in the countryside, you would find life less stressful.
